Notice of Refuse & Recycling Contractor Transition

December 21, 2011

Dear Manassas Park Resident;

As of December 31, 2011, the Service Agreement between American Disposal (Refuse & Recycling Contractor) and the City of Manassas Park will expire.

Following a competitive bidding process, the City has authorized a Service Agreement with **Patriot Disposal, Inc.** to provide collection and disposal of Refuse (household trash), and processing of Recyclables/Yard Waste for Manassas Park residential and municipal customers.

This agreement will take effect on January 1, 2012.

SINGLE-FAMILY CURBSIDE RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Under the new program, Manassas Park residents will retain their 96 gallon trash carts (one per household) as currently provided.

On February 1, 2012, Patriot Disposal will begin repair/replacement of damaged trash carts throughout the City. They will also begin replacement of the 10 -16 gallon recycling bins with one (1) 64 gallon Recycling cart per household, offering residents an opportunity to increase their current recycling capacity.

Residents who have purchased their own Refuse/Recycling container(s) or would prefer to maintain their current service receptacles should contact Patriot Disposal (703) 257-7100 before February 1, 2012.

Collection Days: Trash and Recycling collection will continue uninterrupted on Wednesdays from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Please make sure your trash/recycling is at the curb no earlier than 4:30 PM Tuesday evening and no later than 6:45 AM Wednesday morning.

TRASH/RECYCLING PLACED AT THE CURB ON WEDNESDAY AFTER 7:00 AM MAY NOT BE COLLECTED.

MUNICIPAL/MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Refuse & Recycling Collection service at municipal and multi-family locations will continue uninterrupted, beginning no earlier than 7:00 AM and ending no later than 7:00 PM.

Buildings or communities that utilize front-end receptacles and/or self-contained compactor units should continue to use existing containers currently provided by the facility under the current agreement.

The Dept. of Public Works and Patriot Disposal have worked tirelessly in an effort to make the contractor transition process as smooth as possible for our residential and municipal customers.
