Listed below are some of the questions and concerns of the senior citizens at Park Place.

- *Question about notices a resident had seen about water quality.
- *Resident had concerns about 'drag racing' along Manassas Drive.
- *Wanted to know the status of the handicap accessible van.
- *Question about how to get all of the senior citizens involved in the programs within the city. Vice Mayor Polk stated that staff would look at the concern of information dissemination and try to work up some sort of enhanced marketing plan. Department of Parks & Recreation committed to creating some sort of newsletter just for seniors. We also suggested the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee take a lead role in a forum to identify program opportunities that the seniors need.
- *'Code Red' program was briefly mentioned as a way to target seniors from the database (the city purchased this program over a year ago but it is still not installed or active).
- *Discussed the City Center timeline and ribbon cutting on Oct. 25th.
- *Discussed the new community center.
- *Question about why the fire engine comes to Park Place when only an ambulance is needed.
- *Question about the process for heating and cooling assistance.

With consensus of Governing Body, Vice Mayor Polk adjourned the meeting.
